**2012 Peter Adams International Internship Program
sponsored by the Keck Center**

The Keck Center for International and Strategic Studies will offer financial assistance for students to participate in an international learning and work experience related to career plans.

The internships are open to all CMC sophomores and juniors. Preference will be given to International Relations majors. The internships must be international in substance, and may be with private corporations, government departments, and non-governmental organizations. Internships may be domestic in location. For example, a student could receive Keck Center support for an internship at the Department of State in Washington, D.C. The internships are not valid for travel to countries under a State Department travel warning.

Students must find their own internships, and preference is given to projects that students develop themselves rather than projects initiated by organizations that charge a fee for their services.

Stipends will range from \$2,000 to \$5,000. Awards will be based on the academic record of the applicants, relevant activities outside the classroom, letters of recommendation, and the substantive merit of the internship proposal, which should reveal the nature of the internship and its connection to the applicant's intellectual, personal, and career interests.

Applications will be evaluated by a committee composed of the Director of the Keck Center for International Strategic studies (or his or her designee), a representative of Career Services, and the chair of the International Relations Program. Academic credit may be obtained for the internship according to CMC rules for internship credit. Internship registration forms can be obtained from the Registrar and are due in the Registrar's office by the end of the Spring semester for summer internships. The Keck Center will offer an honorarium of \$250 to faculty members who assist students in obtaining academic credit for their internships.

Within one month of returning to campus all Keck Center International Interns must submit a written report (3–4 pages) about their experience to the Director of the Keck Center for International Strategic Studies, explaining their duties, what they accomplished, and assessing the value of the internship to their academic and career objectives.
